



## 2022 June Holiday Bootcamp GCE 'O' Level Social Studies

The intent of the intensive modular workshop is to equip students with practical examination skills to answer both Structured Response Questions (SRQs) and Source-Based Questions (SBQs). More importantly, the workshop is targeted at helping students achieve distinctions in the 'O' Level examination. Through the workshop, students will be able to provide answers that will strategically improve their scores in the exam paper.

In this workshop, students will be given specimen papers to hone their examination skills. These essential practices will equip students with effective techniques in giving, clear, precise and relevant answers. Furthermore, this workshop will enable students to make strategic adjustments to their answers to maximise their marks in the various sections of the examination paper.
