



2020 Stay@Home May Holiday Bootcamp GCE 'A' Level JC1 History H2

The H2 History workshop aims to provide students with an overview of topics covered in both Papers 1 & 2, and how to connect learning outcomes and the content covered in school. On top of clarifying doubts on these topics, the bootcamp also provides opportunities for students to have hands-on practice on tackling both sample essay and source-based questions.

Students will acquire techniques to best approach these questions and the common pitfalls to avoid. Students who need revision and that extra push for the mid-term examinations will find these lessons helpful.
